ANIMA Holding: February 2018 net inflows.

Milan, 8 March 2018 - ANIMA Group recorded in February 2018 positive net inflows for around €64 million, with total ytd net inflows for around €409 million; total assets under management reached at the end of the month around €94.3 billion, with approx. 29% increase yoy.

"The correction that equity markets recorded between the end of January and the first part of February clearly influenced the investment dynamics of clients, slowing down as usual their short-term choices; the overall result remains however positive thanks to the completeness of our offer and to the contribution of the various channels", commented Marco Carreri, CEO of ANIMA Holding and of ANIMA Sgr.
