ANIMA Holding: October 2018 net inflows

Milan, 8 November 2018

ANIMA Group recorded in October 2018 negative net inflows for around €73 million, with total ytd net inflows positive for around €0.8 billion; total assets under management reached at the end of the month €101.2 billion, with approx. 34% increase compared to AuM at the end of October 2017.

"The month of October was in the first half in line with the very positive trend of Q3, and then in the second half retail flows slowed down following a more cautious customers' behavior reacting to in increased instability of the macroeconomic and financial scenario; the key differentiator for the final result was, however, the expiration of an insurance product toward the end of the month for approximately €200 million", commented Marco Carreri, CEO of ANIMA Holding.
