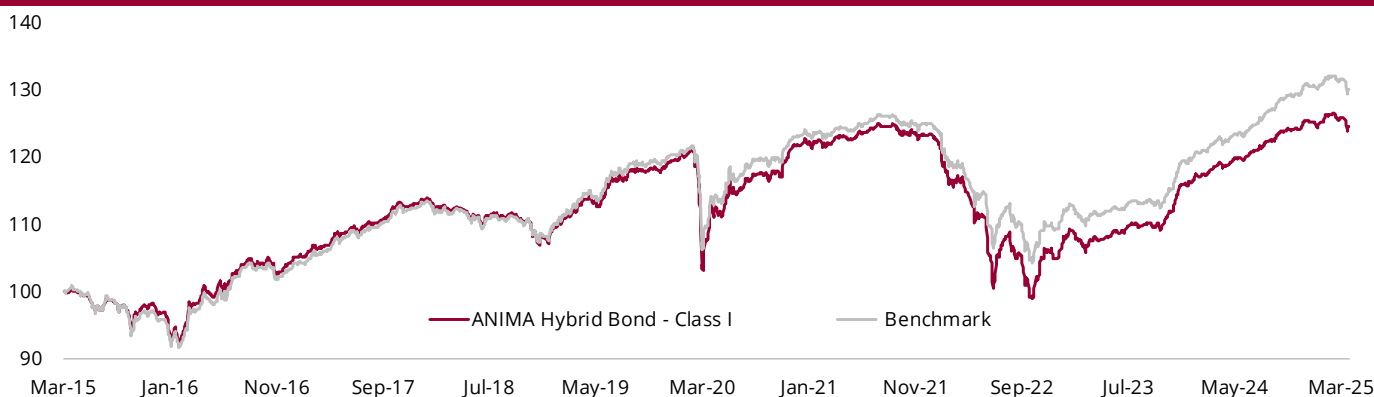

Monthly Fund Manager’s comment

In March, the fund delivered a negative absolute performance and a slight underperformance relative to the benchmark, primarily due to rising interest rates in Europe following the announcement of extraordinary investments by EU governments. Meanwhile, the U.S. yield curve outperformed its European counterpart. During the month, the issuance of new hybrid bonds by U.S. and Canadian companies continued, albeit at a slower pace. As a result, these issuers have been incorporated into the benchmark, representing approximately 25% of its composition.

Currently, we maintain a tactical underweight in U.S. issuers while expanding our coverage of the broader investable universe in light of the new issuance structure.

The fund continues to maintain a slightly underweight duration relative to the benchmark, despite the absolute portfolio duration increasing to 2.91 years.

Our recent activity has focused on participating in primary market transactions, primarily from U.S. and Canadian companies, and rebalancing the portfolio to efficiently and promptly reflect these recent developments.

As of the end of March, corporate bonds accounted for 79% of the portfolio, driven by the compressed sub-senior spread and low hybrid compensation. Our allocations remain tilted toward countercyclical sectors. Utilities represent 34% of the NAV, followed by energy at 22% of the NAV and non-cyclical consumer sectors at 7.9% of the NAV.
