Long-lasting strategy, launched in 1997 (share class with longest track record) with same lead PM



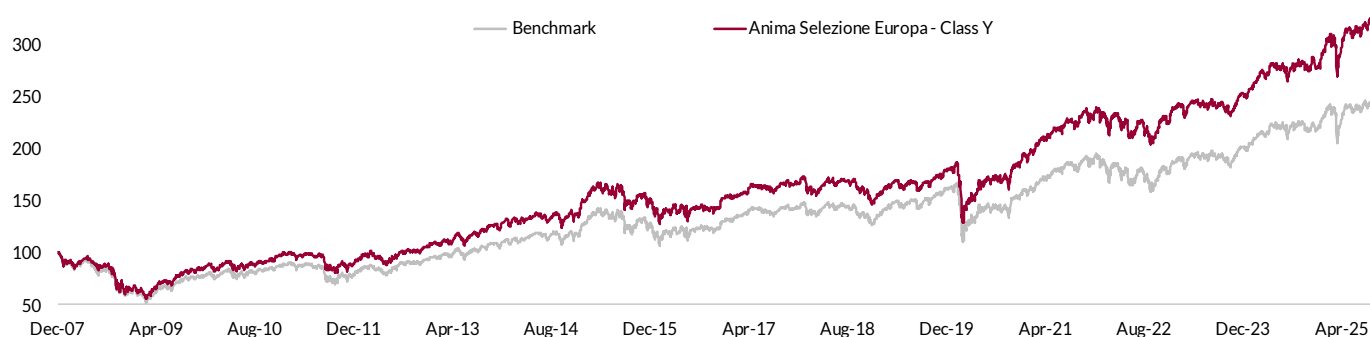

Monthly Fund Manager's comment

Global equity markets posted a positive performance in September (MSCI World c. +3.1%), with the European market (STOXX 600 +1.5%) underperforming the US market (S&P 500 c.+3.5%). From a sector perspective, Basic Resources (+9.2%), Retail (+8.2%) and Technology (+6.8%) recorded the best relative performance, while Food&Beverage (-4.8%), Chemicals (-3.4%) and Telecom (-2.6%) underperformed the market.

The Anima Europe Selection fund had an absolute performance of +3.3% vs benchmark return of +1.5% (+1.8% active return). The main contributor to the monthly performance has been stock picking which contributed around 1.6%. In particular, positive contribution came mainly from materials (OW in Fresnillo and Anglo American), industrials (OW in Airbus, Rheinmetall), and financials (OW in SocGen). On the other hand, negative contribution came from technology (UW in ASM International, OW in Microsoft). Over the past month, sector allocation has remained broadly stable, with only a few adjustments. We increased the exposure to the value/cyclical component of the fund, in particular we increased the OW in Materials, and we increased the exposure to Semicap Equipment within Technology; on the other hand, we reduced the exposure to Staples and Telecom. We continue to have a constructive view on Industrials, Luxury, Tech, Materials, while maintaining our an underweight stance in Energy, Insurance, Staples, Utilities and Financials.

Equity markets have rebounded more strongly than anticipated from their early April lows. This recovery has been fueled by several key drivers: the 90-day pause in tariff implementation, the stabilization of US Treasury yields below 4.5%, and tighter credit spreads. Additionally, renewed enthusiasm for the AI thematic, an uptick in soft data, and rising expectations of a Fed pivot have further supported momentum—particularly in the US, where market breadth continues to improve. In Europe, while the STOXX 600 has recently broken out of its recent range, buoyed by idiosyncratic stories like ASML and a rebound in luxury stocks, as well as strength in pharma following the Trump-Pfizer agreement seen as a clearing event, political uncertainty remains a significant headwind. Looking ahead, we believe that the Fed's pivot will continue to broaden market participation, with laggards increasingly joining the rally, particularly in the US, and with European markets likely to follow by year-end.
